

WHAT IS ETRAC?

eTrac is a new system that will improve the Commission's ability to protect the welfare and integrity of the NSW greyhound racing industry.

This will be done by;

- · introducing eTracking, and
- a participant eTrac portal taking day-to-day transactions online making them quicker and easier to complete.

WHAT IS ETRACKING?

eTracking will enable GWIC to monitor and record the whereabouts of every greyhound registered in NSW, in real time, at any stage of its life.

Greyhounds will be tracked through their 'contact' with GWIC. If a greyhound has had no contact with GWIC in the required period, a request to have the greyhound sighted and scanned will be sent to the greyhound's custodian.

HOW OFTEN DO GREYHOUNDS NEED TO HAVE CONTACT WITH GWIC?

Racing greyhounds - at least once every 6 months

Pre-racing and retired greyhounds - at least once every 12 months
