IT'S A HOT TOPIC: As we're in for some very warm weather in the coming months, it is important to keep your eye on the temperature and know what it means for you and your greyhounds.

> 26°C: Racing abandoned when temperature in the kennels exceed 26°C.

32°C: Dogs can be withdrawn from races without penalty. Submit applications prior to the official scratching time for the race meeting.

38°C: All racing abandoned.
