Today the Dubbo Local Court found charges proven against Mr Shane Polson, a greyhound racing participant currently under interim suspension from participating in the industry.

These charges relate to animal cruelty against greyhounds in his possession in Dubbo in 2018.

Mr Polson was the subject of an interim suspension following animal cruelty charges in Victoria.

Ms Lind said "Mr Polson's conduct is abhorrent and unacceptable by participants in the industry and the general community,"

Upon his sentencing, GWIC will finalise regulatory action against Mr Polson.
