NEW REGISTRATION TYPES



The Greyhound Racing Regulation 2019 which commenced on 1 September 2019 requires a number of roles within the NSW greyhound racing industry to be registered with the Commission. These registration types are listed below.

Any current participants performing any of the registration roles listed below were automatically registered on 1 September 2019. However, these participants must apply for the relevant registration type(s) by 31 December 2019. From 1 January 2020, penalties could apply for anyone performing these roles while unregistered.

WHAT ROLE TYPES NOW HAVE TO BE REGISTERED?

Greyhound Race Official - Lure Driver

A person who is responsible for driving and controlling a lure at a race meeting or trial.

Greyhound Race Official - Starter

A person who is responsible for starting a race or trial.

Greyhound Race Official - Judge

A person who judges the outcome of a race or trial and records the finishing positions of the greyhounds in the race or trial.

Greyhound Race Official - Kennel & Track Attendant

A person who performs general kennelling and track duties at a greyhound race or trial.

Greyhound Promoter

A person who offers an interest in a greyhound or invites applications for an interest in a greyhound.

Greyhound Health Assistant

A person who performs massage therapy, acupuncture, non-invasive injury detection and/or chiropractic treatment on a greyhound.

Greyhound Trial Track Proprietor

A trial track proprietor is a person who owns, leases, occupies and/or manages a trial track used by greyhounds which are not owned or leased by the proprietor. A trial track proprietor includes the registration types formerly known as trial track manager and trial track assistant manager.

HOW TO APPLY

Current participants

Current participants must complete the registration form and return it to the Commission by 31 December 2019. No supporting documentation (E.g. police check, ID or photos) are required for current participants as they are already registered.

New participants

New participants must complete the attached registration form and return it to the Commission by 31 December 2019. New participants will also need to provide a national police history check not older than 12 months, a colour passport size photograph, and a copy of their passport or driver license.

REGISTRATION FEES

No registration fees will be charged for the above registration types at this time. Applicable registration fees will be introduced in the 2020/21 registration renewal period.
