4. Feedback in relation to GWIC

- · Work on The Gardens and track preparation.
 - o Preliminary work on the track has been completed.
 - Soil profile sample gathered during this process to be followed up by Wade
 - Observed a reduction in injuries since this work commenced
- Dress Code
 - o Further discussion is being held on this subject with industry participants

5. Emerging Industry issues

- Greyhound transportation and welfare
 - o Noted that both the Code of Practice and POCTAA provide regulatory oversight on this issue
 - Incidents occurred during transport of greyhounds interstate. Compliance is following up allegations
- Breeding Exemption Processes
 - GWIC currently exploring local possibilities of gaining breeding exemption/DNA testing.
 However currently only NZ offers this service
- DPI Animal Welfare Bill
 - o Participant concern regarding prohibitions placed on artificial insemination
 - GWIC was not consulted during the drafting of this bill
 - Is working with DPI and has passed on industry concerns regarding proposed bill and seeking an exemption for greyhounds
 - GWIC will be represented at the consultation meeting which will occur at Dubbo on February 3rd.
