A greyhound owner or custodian who retires a greyhound must provide this form to GWIC within 14 days from the date of retirement.

Clause 10(1)(f) of the Greyhound Racing Regulation 2019 provides authority for the Commission to ask you for information in relation to your greyhound.

Greyhounds As Pets (GAP), RSPCA, friends or family, or other third party.

Under the GWIC Rehoming Policy, a racing greyhound must be provided with a 30 day wind down period before rehoming. If retiring to a person, they must be 18 years old and the 'Getting to know your greyhound' form must be completed and provided to them.

If you retire the greyhound to a person outside of the industry, you must have the greyhound desexed before transfer. For financial assistance with desexing, please contact Greyhound Racing NSW.

Please be aware that when a greyhound is rehomed to a person outside of the greyhound industry, GWIC will register the greyhound on the Companion Animals register in accordance with the *Companion Animals Act 1998*.
