HOW TO....

Register a litter of pups

- 1. Breeder to complete a 'Whelping and Litter Notice' and return it to GWIC within 14 days of the whelp or due date.
- 2. Breeder to submit record of a C3 vaccination at 6-8 weeks.
- 3. Breeder to submit record of a C5 vaccination at 10-16 weeks.
- 4. GWIC's Greyhound Registration Officers will contact the breeder to arrange microchipping and ear-branding of the litter between 12-20 weeks. They will also complete the 'Litter Identification' form.
- 5. GWIC registers the litter and sends 'Greyhound Identification Certificate' to breeder.





From 1 May 2023 all racing greyhounds must have a current vaccination certificate before they can be nominated to race in NSW.

Vaccination Advice

Mandatory vaccinations include:

- ~ 6-8 weeks C3 Vaccination
- ~ 10 16 weeks C5 Vaccination
- ~ Annual C5 Vaccination

GWIC vets also recommend adding a <u>2i Vaccination</u> at the above stages to protect against Canine Coronavirus and Leptospirosis.

Code of Practice - Health Records



A reminder that Part 3 of the Greyhound Welfare Code of Practice requires trainers to keep up to date health records for each greyhound in their care.

If a greyhound is transferred to another owner or trainer, their health records must be provided to the new owner or trainer.

You have the option to renew for one or three years, with a 30% discount offered with 3 year registration renewals.
