

Termination of ear tattooing REYHOUNDS

Greyhounds Australasia has determined that by 1 July 2024 ear tattooing of registered greyhounds will cease nationwide.

Microchipping will now act as the primary method of identification.

HOME: Where a greyhound owner does not wish to retain a greyhound, the owner must ensure, as far as reasonably possible, that the greyhound is prepared for rehoming as a companion animal.
