

## GREYHOUND WELFARE & INTEGRITY COMMISSION DISCIPLINARY ACTION DECISION

Date of decision: 16 April 2024

Name of relevant person: Troy Vella

**Rule no(s).:** R156(x), R156(f)(i)

Charge 1 – R156(x)

Mr. Vella did a thing which, in the opinion of the Controlling Body, constitutes an offence, by associating with a disqualified

person for the purpose of greyhound racing.

Charge 2 - R148(2)

Mr. Vella did a thing which, in the opinion of the Controlling Body, is corrupt, fraudulent or dishonest, by booking trials on

behalf of a disqualified person.

Plea: Not Guilty to both charges

**Disciplinary action taken:** Charge 1 - To issue a fine of \$4000 and an 18-month

suspension, wholly and conditionally suspended for a period of 12 months subject to Mr Vella not breaching this, or any like

rule, in the 12-month period

**Charge 2** - To issue a fine of \$2000 and an 18-month suspension, wholly and conditionally suspended for a period of 12 months subject to Mr Vella not breaching this, or any like

rule, in the 12-month period

## **DECISION:**

- 1. Mr Vella was, at all relevant times, a registered Public Trainer and Breeder with the Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission.
- 2. From or around 16<sup>th</sup> May 2021 until or around 13<sup>th</sup> February 2023 Mr Vella conducted activities on behalf of a disqualified person, including accepting payment to book trials on behalf of the disqualified person.
- 3. On Tuesday 2 April 2024 Mr Vella was issued with a notice of charge and proposed disciplinary action ("Notice"). The Notice issued two charges against him for breaches of the following Greyhound Racing Rules:

## R156(x), Greyhound Racing Rules

An offence is committed if a person (including an official):

. . .

(x) being a registered person or person associated with greyhound racing, associates with a disqualified or warned off person for the purposes of greyhound racing;

## Rule 156(f)(i), Greyhound Racing Rules

An offence is committed if a person (including an official):

. . .

- (f) has, in relation to a greyhound or greyhound racing, done something, or omitted to do something, which, in the opinion of a Controlling Body or the Stewards:
- (i) is corrupt, fraudulent, or dishonest;
- 4. The Notice invited Mr Vella to attend a hearing on Wednesday 16 April 2024, and to enter a plea and make submissions in relation to the charges and proposed penalties. The penalties decision makers proposed were:
  - Charge 1 Rule 156(x) \$5000 fine and a 2-year suspension, wholly and conditionally suspended for a period of 12 months subject to Mr Vella not breaching this, or any like rule, in the 12-month period
  - Charge 2 Rule 156(f)(i) \$3000 fine and an 18-month suspension, wholly and conditionally suspended for a period of 12 months subject to Mr Vella not breaching this, or any like rule, in the 12-month period
- 5. At the hearing held via Microsoft Teams on Wednesday 16 April 2024 Mr Vella entered a plea of not guilty to each charge and made verbal submissions. Following consideration of Mr Vella's pleas and submissions, the decision-makers found the charges proven and determined to impose the following disciplinary action upon him:
  - Charge 1 To issue a fine of \$4000 and an 18-month suspension, wholly and conditionally suspended for a period of 12 months subject to Mr Vella not breaching this, or any like rule, in the 12-month period
  - Charge 2 To issue a fine of \$2000 and an 18-month suspension, wholly and conditionally suspended for a period of 12 months subject to Mr Vella not breaching this, or any like rule, in the 12-month period

- 6. In taking this disciplinary action, the decision-makers considered all evidence, including:
  - Mr. Vella's not guilty plea to both charges;
  - Mr. Vella's registration history within the industry with no like prior offences;
  - Decision makers determined that Mr. Vella ought to have known the person was Disqualified, as opposed to determining that he did know; and
  - Personal and professional circumstances and the length of time between the commencement of the investigation and the date of the hearing.
