

RECORD OF INQUIRY

DATE OF INQUIRY: 16 October 2018

- 1. The Stewards held an inquiry into allegations about the Participant's conduct at the Tamworth Greyhound Racing Club on 15 November 2018.
- 2. The Stewards charged the Participant under Rule 86(g) of the GWIC Greyhound Racing Rules for acting in an aggressive manner and using abusive language towards a Club Official. The Participant denied the Charge.
- After considering the evidence from the Participant, Club Official, Club President and Steward Gail Thorsby, the Stewards determined that the Participant had breached the Rules as charged
- 4. In determining the appropriate penalty, the Stewards took into account:
 - (a) The Participant's licence and other history, including a prior offence under Rule 86(o) where the Participant was warned off for a period of four months.
 - (b) The Participant's significant contribution to the Tamworth Greyhound Racing Club.
 - (c) The Participant's personal and health circumstances, which are not repeated here for privacy reasons.
 - (d) The reference provided by the Participant.
- 5. Having regard to the totality of the facts, the Stewards determined that the appropriate penalty was a period of disqualification of four months wholly suspended on the condition that the Participant complies with the Rules for a period of 12 months.
