Give me 5 - a C5 reminder

Greyhounds must be vaccinated up to C5 level to be nominated for a race that will take place on, or after, 1 October 2023.

To be vaccinated up to C5 level requires either an annual C5 vaccination, or a C3 vaccination every three years and an annual kennel cough booster.

From the Stewards' Box

Circular key - a reminder that successfully completing a straight track satisfactory trial DOES NOT clear your greyhound for circle tracks.

If a greyhound is ordered to undergo a satisfactory trial on a circle track, and successfully completes trial on a straight track instead, it will be cleared for straight track racing only.

If a greyhound incurs an endorsement on a circle track, it must undergo a trial on the circle prior to racing on that type of circuit.
