- Consultation on proposed Local Rule 135
 - Consultation paper noted
 - o GWIC want to start the new rule from 1 November; seeking feedback
 - o GIPAC query whether bitches in season should be exempted
 - GWIC data is telling us that the longer away from racing, the greater the risk of injury
 - O GIPAC this needs to be explained to the industry if the rule is to be supported
 - GWIC the proposed rule is to be put to the Commissioners for consideration along with everyone's feedback; we will inform GIPAC of the outcome
- Outputs of the Rehoming & Prohibited Substances Summit

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- o Rehoming and Prohibited Substances Actions Plans noted
- Development of a drug information app focussing a bit more on blood swabbing
- Superannuation scheme for greyhounds
- Industry preparation for forecast weather during spring and summer 2023/24
 - GWIC Wade and Stewards have discussed the need for preparation with clubs
 - Shae and the Comms team have been communicating the need for participants to have an emergency plan; being prepared, travelling to and from tracks, air conditioning etc.
 - O GIPAC what is being done about trailers & aircon are these to be made compulsory?
 - GWIC The Code doesn't require air con, but does specify how frequent stops are to be;
 and other things that would need to be complied with under the Code if travelling.
 - GWIC Kristy has undertaken a number of audits when at Gosford and noted that many have moved to air conditioned vans
