

# NOTIFICATION OF EMERGENCY EUTHANASIA



GWIC must be notified whenever a greyhound is euthanased. This form is to be used to notify GWIC that a greyhound has been euthanased to relieve its suffering, by a person other than a registered veterinarian, because a veterinarian was unable to attend in a timely manner.
