- Publication of Disciplinary Matters Matt Tutt
 - Raised proposal to refrain from publishing disciplinary matters on the GWIC website when a participant is charged. In future, will only be published when decision is reached
 - o Noted that communication with clubs regarding interim banned participants will still occur

- Brood Bitch Leasing
 - o Is being explored as part of the new rules to be introduced in early 2022
 - o Noted the exploration of combined whelping and breeding registration
 - o New systems which will be implemented into MyGWIC will allow for use of scanner to register new greyhound pups
- Break-in facilities
 - Noted that there is a lack of access to these in regional areas in particular
- Annual Report
 - Has been delivered to the Minister for tabling at Parliament. Will be circulated to Council
 members once available. Noted growth in the industry and lowering of age demographic of
 participants in particular.
