KEY CHANGES TO THE POLICY

Effect of surrendering greyhounds

The registration of a participant who surrenders a greyhound to a Controlling Body will be cancelled and the participant will not be eligible for registration for a period of <u>five years</u>. Surrender means permanently relinquishing ownership of a greyhound to a Controlling Body. Planned transfer of a greyhound to GAP or another rehoming organisation does not constitute surrender - rehoming is encouraged!

Restrictions on rehoming

Participants must not, without the prior approval of the Commission, transfer a greyhound to an unregistered person who:

- resides at the <u>same address</u> as a participant OR
- resides at a registered kennel address.
