

GREYHOUND WELFARE & INTEGRITY COMMISSION DISCIPLINARY ACTION DECISION

Charge(s): Mr Roylett administered a treatment to a greyhound on the day

of a meeting in circumstances not approved by a Controlling

Body

Plea: Guilty

Disciplinary action taken: To issue a fine of \$500

INVESTIGATION:

- 1. Mr Roylett was, at all relevant times, a registered Owner Trainer with the Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission.
- 2. On 23 May 2025 Mr Roylett presented the greyhound Wild Reggie at the Richmond Greyhound Club for the purpose of competing in race 5.
- 3. During kennelling prior to the meeting, it was brought to the attention of Stewards that a cream had been applied to the Greyhound.

DECISION:

- 4. On Thursday 29 May 2025 Mr Roylett was issued with a notice of charge and proposed disciplinary action (Notice).
- 5. In the Notice issued on 29 May 2025 the decision makers charged Mr Roylett with an offence under Rule 145(1) of the Greyhound Racing Rules, which reads:

Rule 145(1), Rules

(1) An offence is committed if, without the permission of the Stewards, a person administers, causes to be administered, or attempts to administer any treatment to

a greyhound at any time on the day of a meeting until that greyhound is no longer presented for an Event

- 6. The Notice invited Mr Roylett to attend a hearing on Tuesday 17 June 2025 at which time he would have the opportunity to enter a plea and make submissions in relation to the Charge and proposed penalty. The penalty proposed in the notice was a \$1,000 fine.
- 7. On Tuesday 10 June 2025 Mr Roylett's representative contacted decision makers and;
 - entered a plea of guilty; and
 - provided written submissions
- 8. Following consideration of Mr Roylett's plea and submissions, the decision makers found the charge proven and determined to impose the following disciplinary action upon him:

Charge 1 – Rule 145(1) – Fine of \$500

- 9. In taking this disciplinary action, the Commission considered all relevant material and evidence, including:
 - Mr Roylett's Guilty plea; and
 - Mr Roylett's disciplinary record, with no prior like offences.
