



INQUIRY INTO THE FITNESS TO RACE OF THE GREYHOUND IRINKA LINDSAY

Stewards today concluded an inquiry into the circumstances surrounding the standing down of the greyhound 'Irinka Lindsay' from racing, pursuant to Rule 169(5)(a) of the Greyhound Racing Rules, on 18 August 2025.

The stand down was imposed pending an assessment of the greyhound's fitness to compete following veterinary concerns raised at that time.

The inquiry considered specialist veterinary advice obtained in relation to 'Irinka Lindsay'. That advice was subsequently reviewed by the Commission's Chief Veterinary Officer, who confirmed that the greyhound was fit to return to racing.

After considering all available evidence, Stewards have determined that 'Irinka Lindsay' may resume racing under conditional clearance. The clearance is subject to the requirement that the greyhound undergo periodic veterinary reviews to monitor ongoing fitness to race.
