Charge(s): **Charge 1 – LR34B(2)**
Miss Bock, when directed to complete overdue eTrac Check-ins for greyhounds in her care failed to comply with this direction.

Plea: Charge 1 – No plea entered.

Disciplinary action taken: Charge 1 – To issue a suspension until such time her greyhounds are checked-in or the relevant end of life or retirement notifications are completed and submitted.

DECISION

1. Miss Bock was at all relevant times, a registered Owner with the Greyhound Welfare and Integrity Commission.
2. At all material times the greyhounds, the subject of the charges was registered in Miss Bock's ownership.
3. On Thursday, 2 October 2025, following an investigation by the Commission, a Notice of Charge and Proposed Disciplinary Action ("Notice") was issued to Miss Bock. The Notice issued a charge under the Greyhound Racing Rules alleging a breach of the following:

Charge 1: Local Rule 34B (2) – Provision of Information relating to a greyhound

(2) Where a greyhound owner or trainer has received a direction to present a greyhound or greyhounds to a specified place for the purposes of accounting for the greyhound but has failed to comply with that direction, the Controlling Body may refuse to allow nomination of a

greyhound kept by that owner or trainer until the greyhound subject to the direction is accounted for.

4. The Notice invited Miss Bock to make submissions in relation to the charge and proposed penalty. The penalty proposed in the Notice was:

Charge 1 - To suspend Miss Bock until such time her greyhounds are checked-in or the relevant end of life or retirement notifications are completed and submitted.

5. On 3 October 2025, Miss Bock contacted the Commission seeking guidance on the process required to complete the check-in for her greyhound.
6. On 7 October 2025, the Commission provided Miss Bock with instructions on how to complete the check-in for her greyhound.
7. As at the date of this decision, the greyhound in question has not been checked-in.
8. The decision makers found the charge proven and imposed the following penalty:

Charge 1 - To suspend Miss Bock until such time her greyhounds are checked-in or the relevant end of life or retirement notifications are completed and submitted.

9. The Commission's inquiries into the matter remain ongoing.
