On 1 November Greyhounds Australasia will be introducing new Racing Rules, including GAR39 which states a greyhound is not eligible to compete in more than a combined total of:

Tips to help you get a jump on fleas

With warm and humid weather comes the peak time for fleas, so here are some ways you can help prevent an infestation:

- Apply flea treatments to all greyhounds
- Regular grooming
- Regularly wash bedding/rugs in hot water
- Regular vacuuming
- Keep grass short, remove leaf litter
- Give all greyhounds an adequate dose of medication
- Consult with your veterinarian



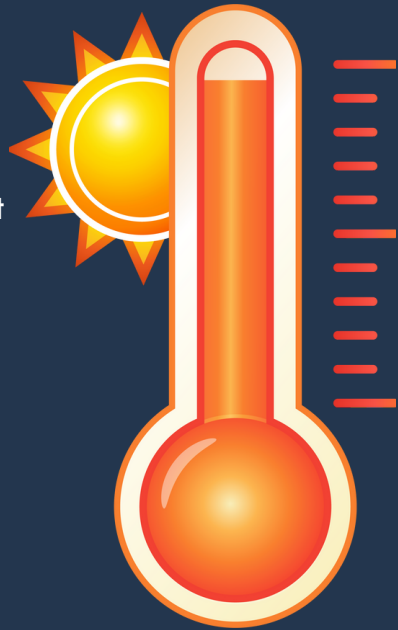

HYDRATE YOUR MATE:
A reminder that on days when the temperature is forecast to exceed **32°C at any time** at the venue, all greyhounds must be provided water in race day kennels in order to race.
This is regardless of any exemption.

Part 9: Rehoming Greyhounds as Companion Animals

LOOKING FOR A NEW HOME?:
Greyhounds must be desexed prior to being rehomed as a companion animal. Participants must not rehome a greyhound to a person who is under the age of 18 years.
