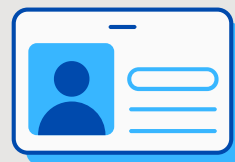

- 3) Select 'MyID'

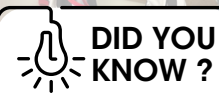


End of Surgical Artificial Insemination

Greyhounds Australasia will prohibit the practice of Surgical Artificial Insemination in greyhounds nationwide from 1 January 2026.

Place bets on another greyhound in the race



Bet on another greyhound to finish ahead of yours



Have a bet placed on another greyhound to finish ahead of yours



Receive a benefit connected with the laying of your greyhound
