Any person applying for registration as an Attendant, Trainer, Breeder-Owner, Breeder-Whelping or Health Assistant.

The Registration Knowledge Tests are based on the information contained within the handbooks.

How many questions are in the Registration Knowledge Tests?

The Registration Knowledge Tests consist of between 10 and 25 multiple choice questions.

How do I complete the Registration Knowledge Test?

The Registration Knowledge Tests form part of the application process on the eTrac portal.

When you're ready to apply, you'll be asked the Knowledge Test questions within your registration application.
