Highlights from the Annual Report

The Commission's 2024/25 Annual Report shows that we are continuing to drive a responsible and resilient future for the NSW greyhound racing industry.

Highlights of the report include:

- 29% reduction in on-track euthanasia and sudden death on 2023/24
- 8% reduction in serious injuries
- 19,143 individual greyhounds checked in
- 496 kennel inspections were undertaken
- New-look website launched
- Swabbing notifications added to eTrac



Checking in on time

Our Greyhound Check-in Policy helps us to protect greyhound welfare by ensuring that the whereabouts of all greyhounds registered in NSW is known.

Participants who fail to check in greyhounds by the due date may face suspension.
