



Standards of dress



To promote the image of greyhound racing in NSW, the Greyhound Welfare & Integrity Commission has developed a Standard of Dress.



ALL RACE MEETINGS

A neat and tidy appearance is requested for all race meetings. The following code applies to trainers and handlers participating in greyhound race meetings in NSW. Catchers should also be dressed neatly eg. Jeans and a collared shirt.

Black or navy pants OR knee length skirt

Black enclosed shoes with dark socks

Black or navy jacket

Plain black beanie

GRNSW issued polo shirt (unless exempt)

Cap or wide brimmed hat (no offensive logos)

Black or navy jacket (no offensive logos)

Gumboots may be worn with prior stewards approval



SEASONAL REQUIREMENTS

During the summer racing season from 1 October - 31 March, **black or navy tailored dress shorts are permitted.**

During the winter racing season from 1 April - 30 September, **shorts are not permitted.**



WENTWORTH PARK

Wentworth Park requires black or navy pants or skirt at ALL race meetings. **NO** shorts are permitted for trainers and handlers.



NOT PERMITTED

No joggers, thongs, sandals or high heels

No leggings, tracksuit pants, cargo pants or casual shorts



The Commission's stewards may penalise participants at their discretion for failing to comply with the standard of dress.
