Remember to spread the puppy love! If your breeding female has whelped, you must notify GWIC about the new greyhound litter within **14 days**.

Simply use the eTrac portal to fill out the Whelping Notice and Litter Registration form.

Biosecurity: The first line of defence

Good biosecurity and hygiene practices play a key role in helping to protect your greyhounds. There are some simple but effective steps that you can take.



- Use gloves, boots
- Regular cleaning & disinfecting
- Don't share bedding/utensils
- Isolate infected greyhounds

Part 4: Greyhound Breeding

Unless directed by a veterinarian, puppies must not be sold, leased or otherwise transferred before 8 weeks of age.
