DISCIPLINARY ACTION DECISION

Charge(s): Mr Gregg Mills presented the greyhound 'Olympia Izmir' for the purpose of competing in race 1 at the Wagga meeting on 29 December 2025 in circumstances where the Greyhound was not free of any prohibited substance
Prohibited Substance(s): Aminocaproic Acid
Plea: Guilty
Disciplinary action taken: To issue a \$500 fine

To issue a four week suspension, with the suspension wholly and conditionally suspended for 12 months conditional on Mr Mills not breaching this, or any like, rule in this period.

INVESTIGATION

Following receipt of a certificate of analysis from Racing Analytical Services Limited dated 23 February 2026, the Commission conducted an investigation into the results of a post event urine sample taken from the greyhound, "Olympia Izmir" at the Wagga meeting on 29 December 2025.

Further analysis of the sample was conducted by the Australian Racing Forensic Laboratory confirming the presence of Aminocaproic Acid.

DECISION:

1. Mr Mills is a registered Owner Trainer and Breeder Whelper and the trainer of "Olympia Izmir" ("the Greyhound"). The Greyhound competed in race 1 of the Wagga meeting on 29 December 2025. Following the Event, a urine sample was taken from the Greyhound.

2. The post event swab revealed the presence of Aminocaproic Acid.
3. Aminocaproic Acid is a prohibited substance under Rule 137 of the Rules.
4. On Tuesday 28 April 2026 Mr Mills was issued with a notice of charge and proposed disciplinary action ("**Notice**").
5. In the Notice issued on 28 April 2026 the decision makers charged Mr Mills with an offence under Rule 141(1)(a) of the Greyhound Racing Rules, which reads:

Rule 141(1), Rules

(1) The owner, trainer or other person in charge of a greyhound:

(a) nominated to compete in an Event;

...

must present the greyhound free of any prohibited substance.

...

(3) The owner, trainer or person in charge of a greyhound presented contrary to subrule (1) of this rule shall be guilty of an offence.

6. The Notice invited Mr Mills to attend a hearing on Monday 11 May 2026 at which time he would have the opportunity to enter a plea and make submissions in relation to the charge and proposed penalty.
7. On Wednesday 29 April 2026, Mr Mills contacted decision makers and;
 - Entered a plea of guilty; and
 - Made written submissions
8. In considering the matter, the decision makers considered Mr Mills' plea and submissions, as well as all available evidence. The decision makers found the charge proven and took the following disciplinary action against Mr Mills:

Charge 141(1)(a): To issue a \$500 fine

To issue a four week suspension, with the suspension wholly and conditionally suspended for 12 months conditional on Mr Mills not breaching this, or any like, rule in this period.

9. In taking this disciplinary action, the decision makers considered all evidence, including:
 - Mr Mills' guilty plea (25% reduction);

- Mr Mills' 39-year registration history, with no prior prohibited substances offences; and
- GWIC penalty guidelines

10. In addition, the Greyhound was disqualified from race 1 at the Wagga meeting on 29 December 2026 pursuant to Rule 141(4) of the Rules.
