

## GREYHOUND WELFARE & INTEGRITY COMMISSION DISCIPLINARY ACTION DECISION

Charge(s):	(1) Mr Henderson was convicted by and sentenced in the Goulburn District Court for drug supply, cultivation and possession offences on 3 June 2020.
Disciplinary action taken:	5 years disqualification

## **DECISION:**

- 1. Mr Raymond Henderson was, at the material times, a registered owner in NSW.
- After the Commission became aware that Mr Henderson had been charged with serious criminal offences, on 17 September 2019 the Commission imposed, after providing Mr Henderson a reasonable opportunity to reply, an interim suspension of Mr Henderson's owner registration pending the finalisation of the criminal proceedings against Mr Henderson.
- 3. On 3 June 2020, Mr Henderson was sentenced in the Goulburn District Court and he was convicted of offences relating to the supply of a cannabis, possession of a prohibited firearm and cultivation of a large commercial quantity of cannabis plants.
- 4. The Commission charged Mr Henderson under Rule 95(8)(a)(i), which reads:

(8) The Controlling Body may impose on a person anyone or more of the penalties referred to in sub-rule (1) if -

- (a) the person has been convicted of an offence by any court and the Controlling Body is satisfied that:
  - (i) the nature of the offence is such that the person's continued participation or association with the greyhound racing would be detrimental to the proper control and regulation of greyhound racing.

- 5. Mr Henderson was notified of the charge in writing and provided a reasonable opportunity to reply.
- 6. The Commission found the charge proven and took the following disciplinary action against Mr Henderson:

To disqualify Mr Henderson for a period of 5 years,

with:

- The period of disqualification to commence 2 October 2020; and
- The period of time served under an interim suspension taken into account as time served.
- 7. In taking this disciplinary action, the Commission considered all evidence, including:
  - The objective seriousness of the offences;
  - The period served under interim suspension.
